

GarageBand

1. Open the GarageBand App
2. You recently created a book trailer in iMovie, using the various instruments provided create a soundtrack for your book trailer.
3. Once you have finished your song, save the song, select, and click the share button.
4. Choose the “open in” option. Give you song a title and author and click share and then choose iMovie.
5. This will add your song into iMovie so you can use it with your book trailer.



Notes/Safari/Chrome (or app of your choice)

1. Open the Notes App.
2. Swipe from the right side to the left side of make notes half screen.
3. Pick the app you wish to use with Notes.
4. Use the Notes app to jot down notes about your research from the app of choice.
5. Look at your options for text, bulleted lists, and writing with pencil.
6. Share your notes via airdrop with the instructor.



Assembly

1. Open the assembly app.
2. Using the shapes provided create a robot of your choosing.
3. Once you have created the robot of your choice, export and save it to your pictures.
4. Open the notes app as well as your pictures app OR assembly app and write a short story (one paragraph) about your newly created robot.



Adobe Photoshop Mix

1. Sign up for a Flickr account (it's free!)
2. Search for a few photos to add to your photo library! The free ones will have the option to "Save to camera roll"
3. Open the Adobe Photoshop Mix App and create an account (also free)
4. Now you can choose a few different photos to mix together. You can overlay them, change colors, hues, and so much more!
5. Save the image to your camera roll and then airdrop it to your instructor.



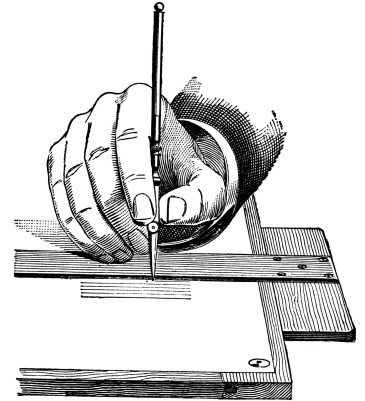
Google Earth

1. Download and Open Google Earth.
2. Choose a location of your choice and enter it into the search box.
3. Take the “Game of Life Guy” and drop him onto any of the blue lines or dots.
4. Visit a few places in the location of your choice.
5. Be sure to take at least 4 different screen shots:
 - a. 2 from the sky with 3D view turned on
 - b. 2 from street view



Drawing App

1. Download and Open one of the suggested Sketching Apps
2. Take the time to look at the various pen/marker styles that you can acquire using the Apple Pencil
3. Create a sketch of your choice using the various tools
4. Save the image to your pictures and share with someone at your table via airdrop.



Quiver

1. Choose one of the provided coloring sheets and color it however you wish!
2. Open the Quiver app and hold the iPad over the picture.
3. The picture should now turn into a 3-D picture with options for questions, looking at the different pieces and parts, etc.
